HANGING BASKETS - 10 INCH



Boston Daisy
(S) Easy to grow. Tolerates drought. Feathery & fragrant foliage. Blooms til fall if deadheaded.



Impatiens
(SH) Compact plants covered with colorful blossoms. Covered in flowers all season. Easy to grow.

Torenia
(S/SH) Fast growing trailing plant, excellent as accent in container plantings & hanging baskets. Thrives in heat.



Ivy Geraniums
(PS) Features thick, lobed, medium green, ivy-like leaves and clusters of single or double flowers in shades of red, pink, lilac or white.



New Guinea Impatiens
(PS or SH) Very showy large flowers with variegated leaves. no deadheading required.

Million Bells
(S) Foliage covered with small bell/petunia shaped flowers. No pinching needed.



Scaevola
(PS) Pretty cascading flowers. Trailing stems, blue fan flowers. Thrives in hot, dry conditions.



Boston Fern
(SH) Easy to grow. Arching, bright green fronds that can grow up to 36". Water & mist frequently.



Gaura
(S) Perennial, blooms May to August, with showy pink or white blossoms



Delphine Violet
(PS) Thrives in heat. Blue violet that stands out.

Strawflower
(S) This flower is in the sunflower family and resembles daisies. It is an annual with flat leaves.



Mexican Heather
(PS) Small, evergreen shrub/ground-cover with tiny leathery leaves and almost continuous small flowers.

Verbena

(S) Low-growing plant with colorful flower clusters and delicate lacy foliage. Good for hot, dry areas.



Supertunia

(S) Vigorous, trailing, everblooming, fast-growing petunia. Drought & heat tolerant. No deadheading needed.

Fuschia

(S) Bicolor cascading flowers have center and outer skirt petals. Blooms through fall. Hummingbirds love it.



4" POTTED PLANTS



Angelonia

(PS) Heat tolerant & low maintenance. Attractive orchid-like flowers on tall spiky stems. Blooms til fall.



Geranium

(S/PS) Lush growing geraniums look good in a bed by themselves, or mixed with other annuals. These versatile plants are perfect for any spot that calls for a splash of vibrant color throughout the season.

Verbena

(S) Low-growing plant with colorful flower clusters and delicate lacy foliage. Good for hot, dry areas.



Begonia

(SH) Low growing plants. Best in rich, moist but well-drained soil. Does not do well with other annuals.



Sun Coleus

(S) Colorful foliage plants. Will display red, green, yellow and pink combinations. Grows 12-15".



Sweet Potato Vine

(S) Larger-leaved vine plant, excellent as accent in container plantings & hanging baskets. Thrives in heat.

4" POTTED PLANTS (Continued)



Begonia: Bronze Leaf
(SH) Low growing plants. Best in rich, moist but well-drained soil. Does not do well with other annuals.



Persian Shield
(PS) Broadleaf evergreen, seasonal bloomer grown primarily for its attractive iridescent purple foliage.

New Guinea Impatiens
(PS or SH) Very showy large flowers with variegated leaves. no deadheading required.



Non-Stop Begonia:
(SH) Blooms summer to fall. Trouble-free - produces a myriad of magnificent flowers in stunning colors. The skirts of petals are packed like those of roses to create a fully double flower with beautiful color intensity.



Lantana
(PS) Trailing branches with deep green leaves & large flowerheads. Pinching results in bushier plants.



Wave Petunia
(S) Versatile, lush-blooming plant. Heat and drought tolerant. Spreads 3-5 feet. Height 4-6".

Dracenan Spike
(S) Spiky, ornamental medium green grass. Upward growing leaves make a striking contrast in planters.



Scaevola
(PS) Pretty cascading flowers. Trailing stems, blue fan flowers. Thrives in hot, dry conditions.



Mexican Heather
(PS) Small, evergreen shrub/ground-cover with tiny leathery leaves and almost continuous small flowers.



Caladium
(SH) Long-lasting & colorful foliage. Ideal for pots & hanging baskets. Pinch off flowers. Poisonous leaves.

Gerber Daisy
(S) Large-leafed plant with large, brightly colored daisy flowers. Needs moist, well-drained soil

GROUND COVER

Springeri Fern

(SH) Evergreen perennial with delicate, fern-like foliage, white flowers & red berries. Ground cover.



Vinca Vine

(SH) Trailing vine with green & white leaves. Good for trailing mixed planters and ground cover.



BEDDING PLANTS



Alyssum

(S) Tiny white flowers on low spreading plant. Produces sweet-smelling flowers.



Melapodium

(S) This is a flowering annual that blooms from spring until fall. The flowers look like little daisies and can get to 6-12" tall. Good for mass plantings.

Celosia

(S) Also known as Cockscomb. Vigorous and self-grooming. 12-18" tall; 12-20" wide. Dries very nicely.



Ageratum

(S) Ageratums have clusters of small blue flowers with a pleasant odor. They are commonly used as a border in gardens or as a bedding plant.



Dusty Miller

(S) Silvery-white plant w/ woolly leaves. Dry to average soil; full sun. Low maintenance. Grows 10-12".



Salvia

(S) Flowered spikes. Blooms early summer to fall if plants are cut back after each flowering flush.

Gazania

(S) Thrives in hot, dry areas. Gerber daisy-like flowers close up at night. Use in ground covers, beddings & pots.



Dianthus

(S) Colorful, double flowers on compact plants. Great for containers, beds, borders, pots & cut flowers.



Nicotiana

(S) Blooms well, great bedding plant, light fragrance.



Snap Dragon

(S) Vertical flower spikes bearing "dragon mouth" shaped blossoms. Well-fertilized soil; full sun.

BEDDING PLANTS (Continued)

Cosmos

(S) Low maintenance. Excellent colorful bedding plants. Great for cut flowers. Grows 24-36" tall.



Petunia

(S) Single-large trumpet-shaped blossoms of 3-1/2" on compact plants. Needs 1/2 day or more full sun.



Dark Leaf Begonia

(SH) Low growing plants. Best in rich, moist but well-drained soil. Does not do well with other annuals.



Green Leaf Begonia

(SH) Low growing plants. Best in rich, moist but well-drained soil. Does not do well with other annuals.



Vinca

(S) Compact bushy plants with showy flower colors and shiny leaves. 10-14" plants. Drought tolerant.



Impatiens

(SH) Compact plants covered with colorful blossoms. Covered in flowers all season. Easy to grow.



Marigolds

(S) Mix-crested rust and gold flowers on 10-12" plant. Blooms heartily all season. Low maintenance.



SPECIALTY POTTED PLANTS & FLOWERS

Kong Coleus

(PS/SH) A dramatically large plant with huge showy leaves great for shaded areas. Up to 22" tall and great for both the garden and displayed in planters. Bring them indoors in the fall and they make a great house plant!

Hibiscus

(S) Perennial shrub with superbly beautiful, colorful and extremely large blooms. Needs well-drained soil

SPECIALTY POTTED PLANTS & FLOWERS (Continued)

Knockout Rose Bush

(S) A perennial bush that continues to rebloom all summer long into the fall and can grow up to 4' tall and wide (red slightly smaller). Resistant to disease and keeps foliage all year long. Its flowers measure about 2.5" each and are made up of 18-25 petals creating an endless mound of color.



Hydrangea

(PS) Plants grow in shrubs from 1-3 meters high with flowerheads at the ends of stems. Color is determined by the ph of the soil. Blooms from early spring to late fall.



TROPICAL PLANTS

Hibiscus

(S) Perennial shrub with superbly beautiful, colorful and extremely large blooms. Needs well-drained soil

Mandevilla

(S) Pretty & prolific trumpet-shaped flowers, beautifully presented against the dark handsome foliage. Fast grower. A great way to quickly screen an eyesore.
