



Dear Parents,

I hope you are enjoying your summer. As you know, we are busy preparing for the arrival of the first day of school and are excited to welcome everyone back. In a recent communication, we explained the changes for this coming year of Extended Day, and our need to register students early this summer for Extended Day. As you may recall, there are limitations on Extended Day due to health and safety concerns. Most notably, there will be no all-day Extended Day (for instance, on holidays or teacher work days), nor can we allow drop-ins. Unlike in past years, we have a **deadline for signing up for Extended Day of July 20, 2020.**

Extended Day Programs:

The *2020-2021 Extended Day Program* will begin Tuesday, August 25, 2020 and run through Tuesday, May 25, 2021. The program is open to Community School students from Nursery through Grade 6. The Program will provide a warm, nurturing environment. A snack will be offered daily. Activities will include outdoor games and sports, table games, crafts, and quiet time for reading and homework.

Students will remain in their homerooms for Extended Day. The dismissal procedure will be included in the policies/protocol information for our school opening later in the summer.

Students may be enrolled in full-time extended day which is three or more days per week, or part-time extended day which is two or fewer days per week. Please choose the days you would like your child to attend when registering on-line.
